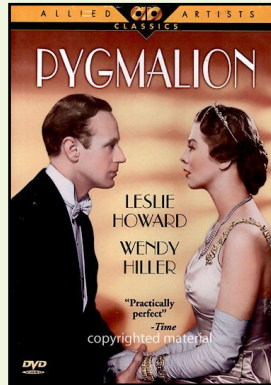


# Described & Captioned Media Program on YouTube
