Summertime fun will be here before we know it. Accessible media (described and captioned) can contribute to the fun and also help children learn. Parents should know this exciting news about the DCMP:

- We have a library of over 8,000 free-loan described and captioned media titles available to registered members. There are no charges for membership or media use.
- Parents of students who are deaf, hard of hearing, blind, visually impaired, or deaf-blind are eligible for membership.
- Parents may create student accounts for use directly by students. The parent managing the student account controls which titles may be viewed.
- Media may be watched online, on mobile devices, on a home TV with a set-top box, or through DVDs mailed from the DCMP.
