VOCABULARY

Quantity	An amount or number of things.
Number Line	A line used to visualize numbers.
Negative Number	A number that is less than zero.
Equal	When two groups contain the same number or amount.
Measuring	A way to determine the size or amount of something.
Volume	The measure of how much space is inside an object, for example how much liquid a container can hold.
