VOCABULARY

Cardinal Numbers	Counting numbers.
Ordinal Numbers	Numbers that tell order.
Nominal Numbers	Numbers that are used to name or identify.
Digits	The numbers 0 – 9, which can be combined in different ways to write any number.
Place Value	The value of a digit based on its position in a number.
Fraction	A number that represents a part of a whole.
