### VOCABULARY

Money	What people use to buy things they need and want.
Value	The number of dollars or cents a bill or coin is worth.
Decimal Point	The small dot that separates dollars from cents.
Change	When you give more money than your item actually costs, the cashier subtracts the cost of your item from the amount you have paid. The difference is given back to you in change.
